

Annual Leaf Collection Policy

A notice will be posted on the City website (http://www.kingstontn.gov) and also on social media and in the Roane County News.

Leaves left for collection must meet the following guidelines:

ONLY LEAVES WILL BE COLLECTED

- Leaves must be free of tree branches and twigs as these can cause the vacuums to clog.
- Our equipment is unable to collect leaves placed beneath overhead obstructions, such as tree limbs or low hanging utility cables.
- Leaves must be brought to the curbside and not placed in the street, on sidewalks, or where it blocks utility meters, poles, or fire hydrants, parking spaces or drainage ditches
- All leaves must be placed outside fenced areas. If there is no other location on your property to rake your leaves, rake them to the end or side of your driveway.
- · Leaves can also be placed in plastic bags.
